CHEST XRAY 1 VIEW, DATED 12/16/07 AT 00:37

REPORT: Supine chest.

Comparison: From July 27, 2005.

The lungs are hypoinflated. Cardiac silhouette is enlarged. There is mild  
edema and bibasilar atelectasis. No pleural effusion is seen.

IMPRESSION: Mild edema and bibasilar atelectasis. Hypoinflated lungs.
